

# JUNJI ITO

## CREATOR / FEATURED GUEST

Junji Ito made his professional manga debut in 1987 and since then has gone on to be recognized as one of the greatest contemporary artists working in the horror genre. His titles include *Tomie* and *Uzumaki*, which have been adapted into live-action film; *Gyo*, which was adapted into an animated film; and his short story collections *Fragments of Horror*, *Shiver*, and *Frankenstein*, all of which are available for viewing at JFT. His most recent title *Smashed*, first published in North America April 2019, is a collection of 13 chilling nightmares and is available for viewing at JFT. Ito's influences include classic horror manga artists Kazuo Umezu and Hideshi Hino, as well as authors Yasutaka Tsutsui and H.P. Lovecraft.
